แบบฝึกหัดเพิ่มเติม: กิจกรรมกลุ่ม

1. ให้นักเรียนแบ่งเป็นกลุ่มละ 4-5 คน จากนั้นเดินสำรวจที่ในโรงเรียนหรือในละแวกใกล้โรงเรียน เพื่อหาจุดที่ควรมีป้ายเตือนต่างๆ เช่น พื้นต่างระดับ ระวังศีรษะ พื้นลื่น จากนั้นให้นำมาปรึกษาครู ก่อนที่จะนำไปทำเป็นป้ายจริงและนำไปใช้ในสถานที่ที่แต่ละกลุ่มหามา อนุญาตให้นักเรียนค้นข้อมูลจากแหล่งสืบค้นต่างๆ ได้ตามสมควร
2. ทั้งนี้ ให้ครูเน้นลักษณะภาษาว่า ป้ายมักเป็นประโยคคำสั่ง (เช่น Mind your head. Mind your step. Slow down.) หรือเป็นนามวลีที่ไม่มีกริยาประกอบเฉยๆ (Left turn ahead. Speed bump ahead. School zone.) เป็นต้น

หมายเหตุ: บทเรียนนี้ใช้สอนศัพท์เกี่ยวกับส่วนประกอบจักรยานได้ สามารถใช้แบบฝึกหัดจากเทปผู้จัดการร้านขายจักรยาน ได้
