แบบฝึกหัดเพิ่มเติม: กิจกรรมฝึกพูดในห้องเรียน

1. ให้นักเรียนแบ่งเป็นกลุ่มละ 4-5 คนแล้วนั่งล้อมเป็นวง แต่ละรอบ ครูเลือกวันหนึ่งในปฏิทิน (ครูอาจเลือกไว้ก่อนหรือเลือกอย่างสุ่มในห้องเรียนก็ได้) นักเรียนในกลุ่มทุกคนจะต้องนัดหมายเพื่อนคนที่เหลือในวันดังกล่าว (กิจกรรมที่กำหนดให้ทำอาจเป็น การนัดพบ การส่งอีเมล การนัดส่งงาน เป็นต้น) แต่ต้องใช้คำบอกเวลาไม่ซ้ำกัน เน้นให้นักเรียนใช้บุพบท หรือ preposition คู่กับคำบอกเวลา (เช่น on Monday, within a few days.) เล่นวนเช่นนี้สัก 5-7 รอบ

ตัวอย่าง

(สมมติให้วันนี้เป็นวันจันทร์ที่ 1)

Teacher: The date is Sunday 7. Tell your friends that you will send them an email on that day.

Student 1: I will send you an email **on Sunday**.

Student 2: I will email you **within this week**.

Student 3: I'll make sure to send you an email **in six days**.

Student 4: I will send an email to you - **this weekend**.
