1. This place is also known as Sanam Luang. It is an open field and public square in front of the Grand Palace, Bangkok. It was officially known as Thung Phra Men as it has been used as a site for royal cremations. However, King Rama IV changed the name from Thung Phra Men to Thong Sanam Luang in 1855, but the name is now shortened to Sanam Luang.

Sanam Luang is located in the Phra Nakhon district, the historic center of Bangkok.

2. It is a place where city pillars are housed. It is also believed that this shrine houses the city spirit deity, also known in Thai as Chao Pho Lak Mueng. Many people worship the city pillar shrines as they believe they will bring prosperity and fulfillment in their work and career. Presumably, the first city pillar shrine was erected in Bangkok when King Rama I moved the capital to Bangkok. The shrine is in the heart of Bangkok, opposite the Grand Palace. There are also many city pillar shrines in other provinces.

3. It is a religious structure in the Phra Nakhon District, Bangkok, Thailand. Its wooden pillars are made of teaks. It was formerly used in an old Brahmin ceremony. Although the ceremony was







abolished due to the safety reasons, it now stands as one of Bangkok's tourist attractions, located in front of Wat Suthat.

4. It is a public monument located on Ratchadamnoen Klang Road in the center of Bangkok. The monument was commissioned to commemorate the "1932 Revolution" which led to the establishment of a constitutional monarchy. The centerpiece of the monument is a carved representation of a palm-leaf manuscript box holding the Thai Constitution.

5. Also known as Wat Pho or Wat Po, it is a Buddhist temple complex in the Phra Nakhon District, Bangkok. It is one of Bangkok's oldest temples. The complex houses the largest collection of Buddha images in Thailand, including a 46 m long reclining Buddha. It was also the earliest center for public education in Thailand, and still houses a school of Thai medicine. It is also known as the birthplace of traditional Thai massage which is still taught and practiced at the temple today.

6. Also known as Wat Arun, it is a Buddhist temple in Bangkok Yai district of Bangkok. It is among the best known Thailand's landmarks because it is believed that the first light of the morning reflects off the surface of the Wat Arun Prangs (similar to stupa-like pagodas) which are encrusted with colorful porcelains.
